**SCHOLARSHIPS FOR PURSUING  
POST GRADUATE STUDIES IN MATHEMATICS**

National Board for Higher Mathematics (NBHM) invites applications for the grant of scholarships to Students for pursuing studies for M.A./M.Sc. in mathematics.

**Eligibility**

Applicants should be motivated students with a good Bachelor's degree qualified to pursue M.A./M.Sc. in mathematics.

Applicants should be below the age of 22 years as on January 1, 2000. Exceptional cases will, however, be considered on merit.

**Amount of Scholarship**

The successful candidates will be paid Rs. 1,200/- per month during two years of their studies.

The selected students would be expected to enroll themselves with an appropriate Institution for M.A./M.Sc. degree in mathematics. The scholarships will be paid through the institution which they join. The scholarships are sanctioned for one year at a time and are renewable at the end of the year, subject to satisfactory progress.

Selection will be made on the basis of a written test

and an interview to assess the aptitude of the applicants.

Applications in duplicate along with a recent passport size photograph should be made in the proforma given at the end of this advertisement and sent to the address given below. The envelope should be marked 'NBHM M.A./M.Sc.' scholarships.

The applicants should arrange for letters of recommendation from three teachers to be sent directly to the address appearing below, with the same markings.

A self-addressed post card/stamped envelope should accompany the application for acknowledgment of receipt.

The last date for the receipt of completed applications is **August 20, 2000**.

Candidates called for the written test/interview will be paid railway fares limited to sleeper class (second class) each way and a sum of Rs. 50/- as halting allowance for the day of the test/interview. In case of a bus journey the entitlement towards travel claim will be limited to the fare charged by public buses for travel by their ordinary buses.
