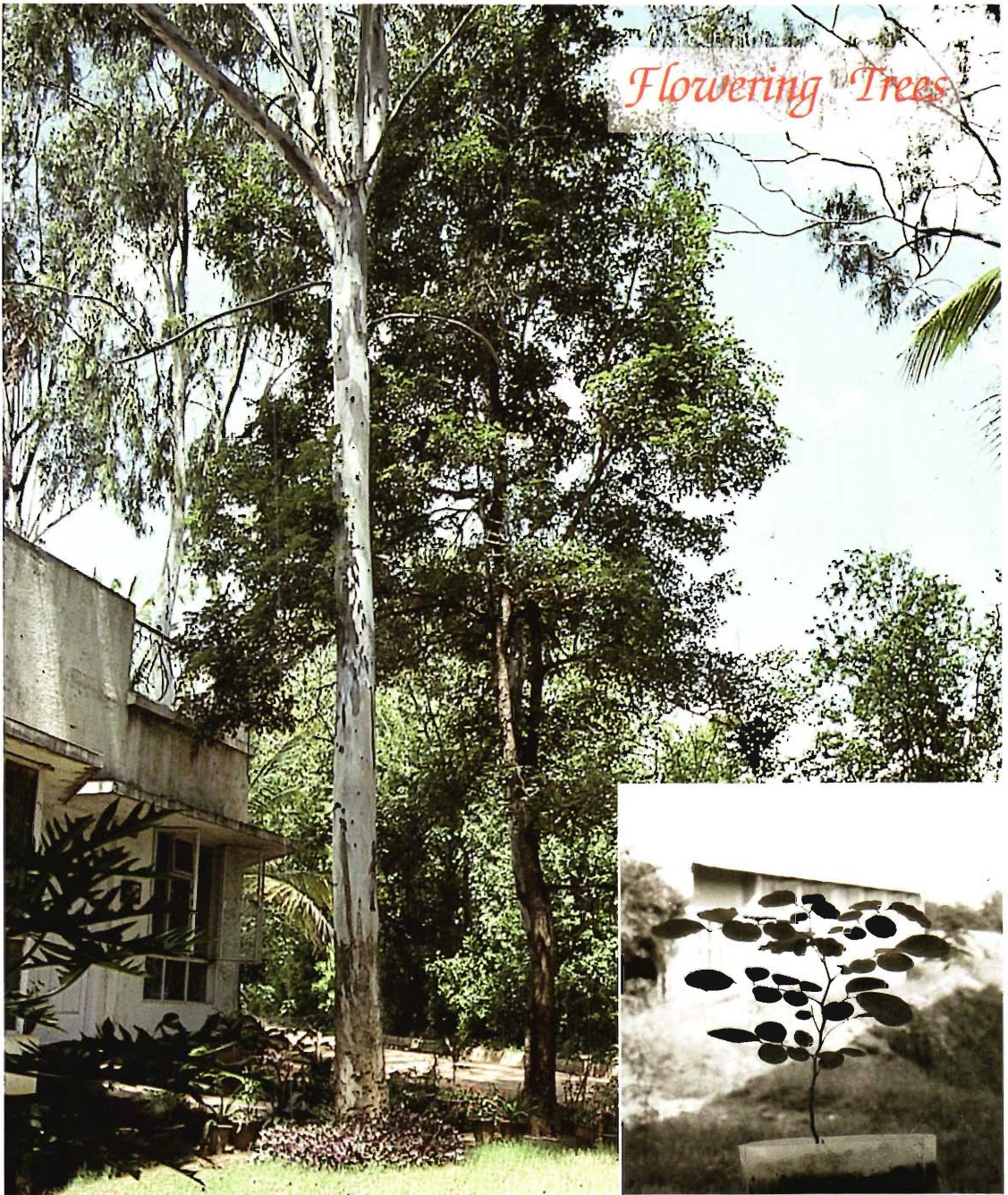


Flowering Trees



Dalbergia latifolia Roxb. (East Indian Rosewood) of Leguminosae is a large deciduous or nearly evergreen tree that grows in mixed deciduous forests with teak. Leaves are compound. The creamy white flowers are borne on branched inflorescences. The indehiscent drypod bears 1-4 seeds. Inset – a juvenile plant.

Rosewood timber is stronger and much harder than teak and ranks among the finest woods for furniture and cabinet work.
