The text accompanying the crossword in the March 2018 issue had some clue numbers incorrect. The full text, with clue numbers corrected, is reproduced below:

1A, (3D, 22A), (5D, 4D), 9A, 18A, 26D, (27D, 22A), 35A are all women who won Nobel Prizes for their scientific work.

8D did scientific work that played a (controversial) key role in work that was awarded the Nobel Prize, we do not know if she would have shared in the Prize, as she had, sadly, passed away by the time the prize was awarded.

33A made a discovery that was awarded the Nobel Prize, but – extremely controversially – the Prize was given not to her, but to her PhD advisor (who had initially refused to believe her results).

12A was a female scientist who lived centuries before the Nobel Prize was even thought of.

9D made an important discovery that makes her currently a hot favourite to win the Nobel Prize in chemistry or biology.

Several other clues are also related to female scientists.
