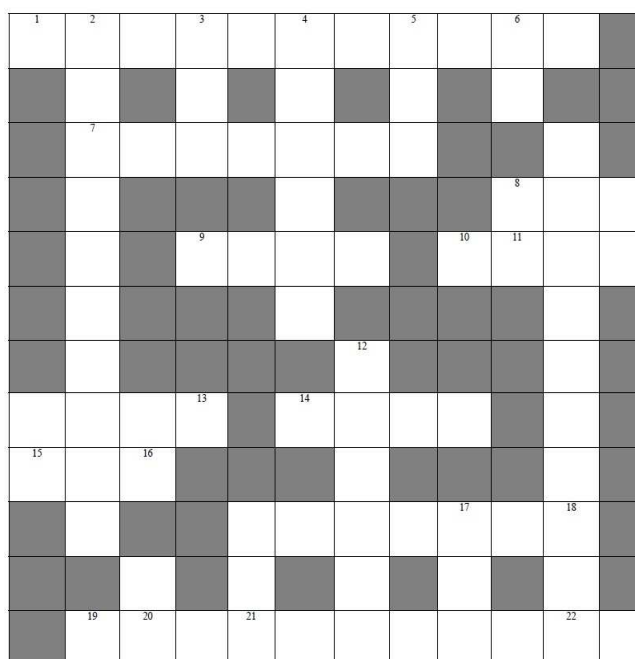


# Crossword
